*Please arrive at this time so we can get the performers ready and have a rehearsal on stage before the show itself.

Key Points (but please read full notice!)

- **COSTUMES:** Will be given out at the last couple of classes before the show
- **ARRIVE ON TIME:** Dancers arrive at the theatre in costume at your call time **with hair done** (see overleaf).
- **TICKETS:** Tickets will go on sale Friday 17th November (reserved seating) at wellingtondance.co.nz/hub/#concert. **Parents, family and friends need to buy tickets to watch the show,** performers & 'parent chaperones' do not need a ticket as they are backstage.

COSTUMES

Costumes will be given out in the last couple of classes before the show. Uncollected costumes can be picked up from the studio Wednesday 6th December .

Please do not wear your costume between then and the show. If you wish to make alterations or swap within your group, please feel free.

Please NAME your costumes and dance shoes. You keep these costumes!

HAIR, SHOES AND MAKEUP

Ballet: Girls - Ballet bun. Staff can help/fix if necessary. Please wear pink ballet socks (**not ballet tights**) and pink ballet shoes. Boys - Neat hair. White ballet shoes with matching short socks.

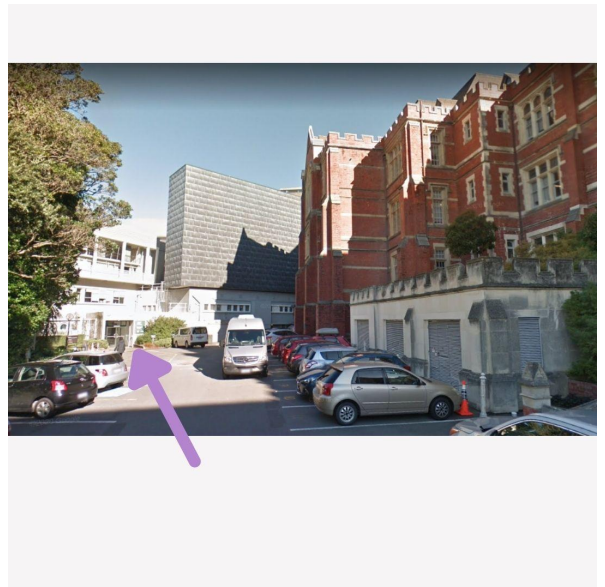
Jazz: Girls - High, smooth ponytail. Black jazz shoes (not pink ballet shoes), **no socks required**. Boys - Neat hair. Black jazz shoes - no socks required.

Hip Hop: Girls - High, smooth ponytail. Clean, white sneakers. Boys - Neat hair. Clean, white sneakers.

Our staff in the green room will apply optional stage lipstick and eye 'flicks'.

ON THE DAY

- ★ Enter the Memorial Theatre via the Student Union entrance next to the Hunter Building (this will be your exit also).
- ★ Walk up the stairs and turn for the 'green room', supervised by our teaching team & crew. After signing your dancer into the hair station, please take all your dancer's belongings with you.
- ★ You and other audience members will wait in the next-door "Bubble" lounge until ushers come to guide them into the theatre after our rehearsal.
- ★ A senior student or parent chaperone will stay with each class, keep them entertained, manage bathroom trips, and get them to and from the stage.
- ★ If you have a very young dancer, or one struck by stage fright on the day you can stay with them, and slip into the theatre in time to watch, or watch from side-stage.
- ★ After the show, we will bring dancers to meet you in the theatre foyer.



THEATRE PARKING

It can be challenging to find a park near the theatre. No parking is permitted in the grounds of the Hunter Building, so try the Pay & Display parks located along Waiteata Road or on Kelburn Parade.

IF YOU HAVE MORE THAN ONE DANCE/ITEM....

Please get ready for your first item (usually ballet, but check the programme above) and place each separate costume, shoes, accessories in a NAMED clear bag. Depending on the length of time available to get ready, performers will be assisted to get changed either near the green room or in a backstage dressing room. We have teachers and backstage chaperones in charge of costume changes.

HOW LONG IS THE SHOW?

Each show has around 10 short items, and then all performers come back on stage to sit down for a final curtain call. Each show will be about 45 minutes long. After the show, we will bring performers to meet you in the theatre foyer and we respectfully ask that you leave the building promptly.

TICKETS

Parents, family and friends will need to buy tickets to watch the show. Performers will be able to watch the show on a screen backstage. All performers will be involved on stage to watch advanced students at the end of the show. Tickets will be available through iTicket from Friday 17th November.

Please ensure you buy tickets for the correct show. Exchanges are at the discretion of iTicket. Tickets are reserved seating, not general admission and all adults and children except babies under 2 on laps need a ticket according to the theatre fire safety policies.

Evening Show: Adult \$35, Child \$25. Length approx 2 hours plus 15 min interval.

Matinee Show: Adult \$29, Child \$19. Length approx 1 hour.

Little Shows – Adults \$25, Child \$15. Length approx 45 min

All shows will be filmed by Broad Media Production & Multimedia. They will provide a professionally filmed keepsake (\$20) for your dancer or a way to share their performance with family members. This year the film will only be available as a download (no DVD option) and will be released within 48 hours of the final show.
