Dancers' Uniform and Hair

We have a studio uniform which helps all our dancers feel a sense of belonging, as well as being dressed for our teachers to be able to see their movements and provide feedback. It doesn't have to be perfect, it just has to be up off your face.

Houses at WDA!

Every WDA student and teacher is assigned to a 'house', either Trimmer (pink), Parris (yellow) or leremia (purple) - named after famous NZ dancers. Teachers let our new students know which house they are in (our preschool and junior students have colour coded name tags!). House points are given by teachers as positive reinforcement for class readiness, effort, attention and participation. Every term there is a winning house, whose members receive a chocolate treat and their house banner displayed in the hallway.

Dropping Dancers off for classes?

We invite and encourage dancers to be early and ready for when their class starts and parents of school age children are welcome to drop their child off at the studio. While we do usually have a team member on the front desk, sometimes studio events or classes require them. Teachers cannot be responsible for children unsupervised in the waiting room. If you are dropping your child off early a good guide is 15 minutes before class starts.

Introducing Miss Manaia





'Pointe Shoe' Colouring Competition


